# From the East

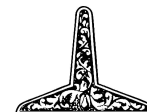


Brethren,

## By-Laws of Pahrump Lodge #54 F. & A. M. Proposed Changes Article XIV. Of the Trustees

### **(Original wording)**

Section 1. In conformity with Article 5, Section 5.242 of the Masonic Code of the Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of Nevada, **and as required by NRS 82.030**, there shall be elected a Board of three (3) Trustees who will act as the business agent of the Lodge. The Secretary of the Lodge shall act as the secretary of the Board of Trustees, but shall have no vote on the Board.

### **(Proposed change)**

Section 1. In conformity with Article 5, Section 5.242 of the Masonic Code of the Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of Nevada, there shall be elected a Board of three (3) Trustees who will act as the business agent of the Lodge. The Secretary of the Lodge shall act as the secretary of the Board of Trustees, but shall have no vote on the Board.

(Rational: NRS 82.030 was repealed in Legislature session in 1991. The wording herein is now such that should changes are made to NRS Chapter 82, this by-law need not be changed.)

### **(Original wording)**

Section 2. The duties of the Board of Trustees shall be in conformity to Article 5, Section 5.246 of the Masonic Code of the Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of Nevada, **and NRS 82.030**. The Board shall enter upon the discharge of its duties at the same time the other officers are installed.

### **(Proposed change)**

Section 2. The duties of the Board of Trustees shall be in conformity to Article 5, Section 5.246 of the Masonic Code of the Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of Nevada. The Board shall enter upon the discharge of its duties at the same time the other officers are installed.

### **(Original wording)**

Section 5. The Master-elect shall submit a proposed budget to the Trustees and the Lodge, for the year he will serve as Worshipful Master; this budget shall be submitted prior to the annual audit of the Lodge books. The budget shall be approved by the Trustees prior to presentation to the Lodge for approval. Expenditures for non-budgeted items, or in excess of the approved budget, must be approved by the Trustees and the Lodge prior to such expenditures.

### **(Proposed change)**

Section 5. The Master-elect shall submit a proposed budget to the Trustees and the Lodge, for the year he will serve as Worshipful Master; this budget shall be submitted prior to the annual audit of the Lodge books. **The estimated normal monthly bills, such as telephone, electric and refuse collection, shall be included in the annual budget.** The budget shall be approved by the Trustees prior to presentation to the Lodge for approval. Expenditures for non-budgeted items, or in excess of the approved budget, must be approved by the Trustees or the Lodge prior to such expenditures.

(Rational: This provision is causes the normal housekeeping bills to be paid without the need of bringing them to the floor for a vote at each stated communication once the annual budget is approved by the membership.)
